ENTRY GUIDELINES

- Pick a category and theme for your tree, get creative! Three Categories are: Traditional, Non-Traditional, and Handmade.
- Please provide all decorations and a tree skirt in addition to an artificial tree (or tree-like structure) to decorate. The Museum will provide extension cords, timers and labels with the text you supply describing your group or business.
- All trees must be artificial. Prohibited items: live plants, cut branches/flowers, wrapped candy or anything edible. Please note that tree location will be determined on a first come basis.
- Have your tree ready for display by 3:00 PM Thursday, December 5th. Museum Hours: Wednesday-Saturday 10:00 AM -3:00PM
